What is it?

The United Nations' 16 days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence and abuse is an annual international campaign.

It takes place from November 25th (International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women) until 10th December (International Human Rights Day)

Domestic Abuse takes many forms, it can be subtle and is nearly always hidden from view. We believe it should not remain hidden and so we speak up and campaign against this, that all can live in peace, in harmony with one another and in safety.

This year Mothers' Union have launched a new campaign:



RISE UP against Domestic Abuse.

Churches are being encouraged to participate, by regularly praying for victims, survivors and perpetrators, for putting up help posters in all buildings, toilets etc and by supporting local places of refuge and support.







For every day of the year, it presents the three services in full and include Bible readings (NRSV translation), psalms, canticles and seasonal variations.


It allows you to:
