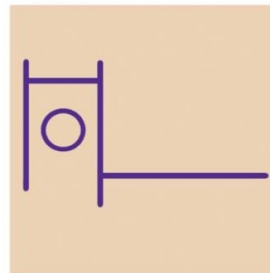
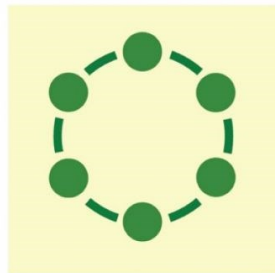
You may be aware that many charities and organisations are struggling at this time, this includes churches.
